


Over 17,000 modules passed in the first year - 99% pass rate!

What was needed

As part of their ongoing Infection Control programme, NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde wanted a way of ensuring that all their staff had received and understood the latest information on infection control.

Sandra McNamee, Nurse Consultant Infection Control, is responsible for informing staff over many sites and organisations. She realised that e-learning would be a highly effective way of reaching these people.

Using Training Tracker, staff can now access the materials at any time over the internet and all the results are stored in a database online for administrators and managers to review.



Launch

Following a successful pilot of the first Hand hygiene module, further modules were prepared and the whole suite was launched early Autumn 2008.

Developing the modules

The ICN at NHS GGC education subgroup developed and quality assured all the materials. It was then a straightforward task to convert PowerPoint presentations into Training Tracker modules.

Local photos and video were used to ensure correct products and procedures were depicted and a series of bug images was commissioned to illustrate modules.

The result is an attractive, informative package with a distinct identity.



Results

The results so far have been amazing!

The Infection Control suite was launched in September of 2008. By mid November over **1,600 modules** had been completed with a 98% pass rate and by June 2009 this had risen to over **12,000** modules passed.

According to Sandra,

"Using Training Tracker I can access the reports at any time to see who has completed their training and who has not yet started.

We can edit and add new modules ourselves and our users appreciate the time that e-learning saves them."
